to the new Food Sampling App and enhanced data options.

Built on OneBlink's Low-code Platform, Victoria's Dept of Health has replaced the app for VIC councils to use when conducting food sampling activities.

The new app is now automatically updated in line with regulatory changes and new sampling fields, without the need to download or re-install new versions.

To better secure and manage your own users of this new app, all Councils now receive access to a 'limited use' version of the OneBlink Platform where you can invite, authorise and manage app users.

The new app provides a number of enhancements to make collecting and submitting food samples easier and faster.

These include:

- 'Drop down' lists for Council names (to reduce typing, inconsistent naming and potential typos)
- Ability to complete multiple samples in a single submission
- Manage your own user pool with secure, user specific logins
- Smarter forms that pre-fill key fields based on previous submissions
- Placeholder, hints, and info elements to add more context to areas of the form
- New testing options added to provide further context to the type of testing, instead of appending then as comments

and it's relevance for DoH Food Sampling form

Under the new app, all food samples submitted are still sent automatically to the analysis labs, and a .CSV file of each food sample is sent back to Councils (as per the current process).

Many of the Councils we have spoken to have expressed concern that they then have to open each email, open the attached .CSV and 'cut and paste' the data from each sample into their own 'master' spreadsheet.

By all accounts this takes a lot of time and is open to error in terms of missing an email/sample, incorrectly selecting the data to 'cut' or where to 'paste' it.

However, this is the only mechanism available to Councils that wish to keep their own copy of the data they collect/submit, keep a history of who/when they inspect premises, and keep count of their overall inspections in line with their gazetted obligations.

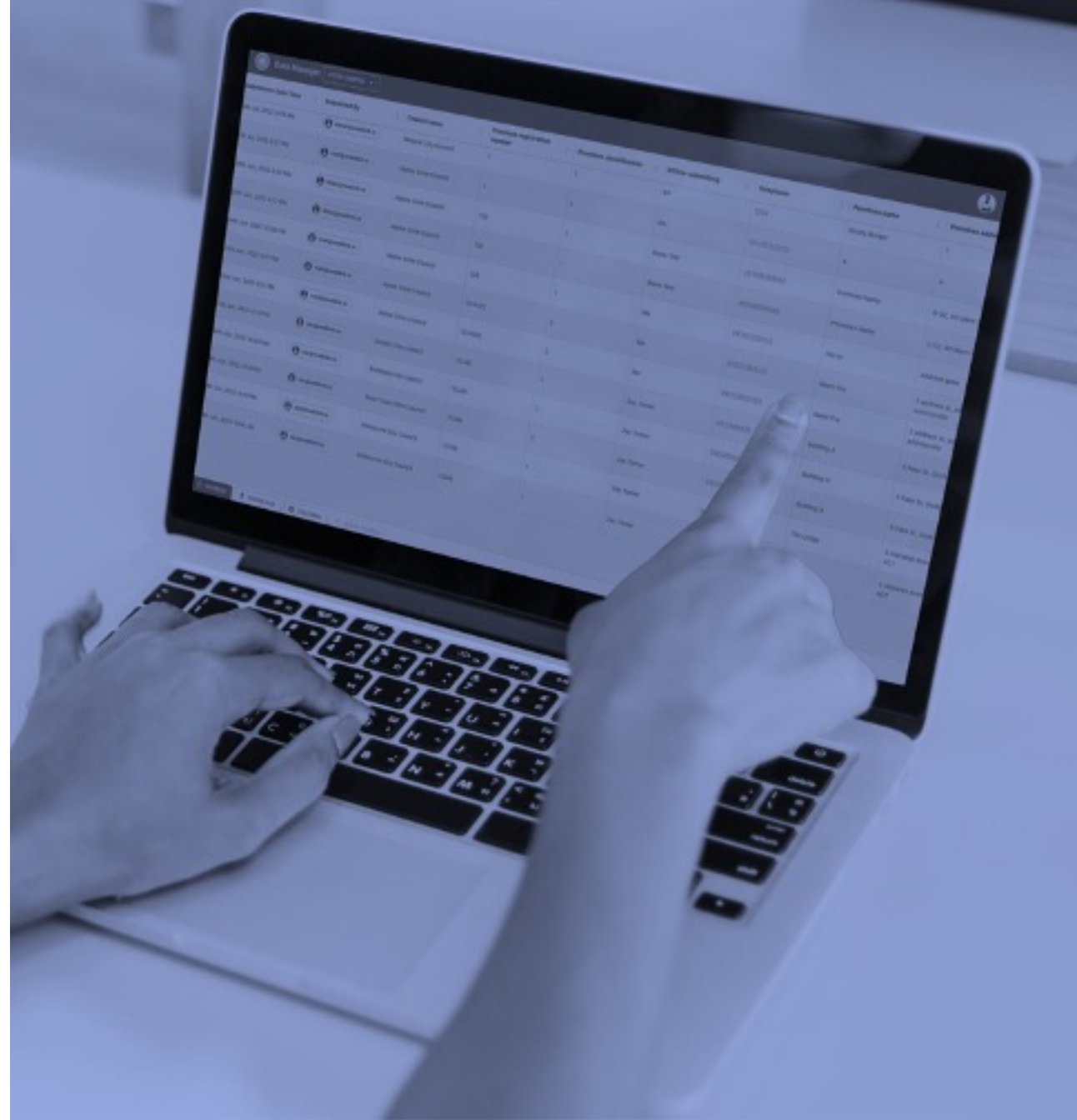

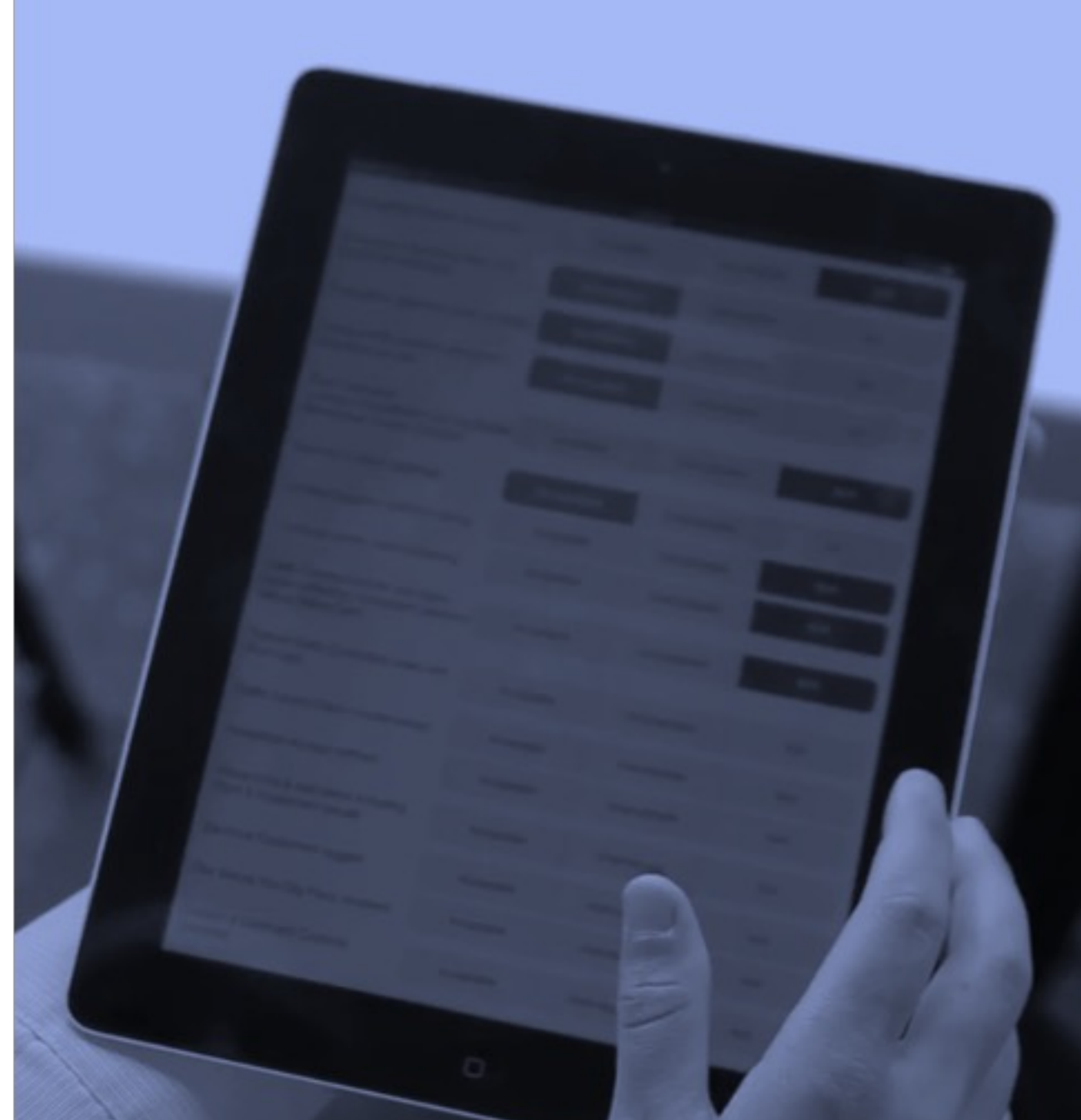
